Leaves honor women affected by breast cancer

GRAND JUNCTION — The Junior Service League of Grand Junction and the Lynette Jennings Foundation have come together to create a project to honor women affected by breast cancer during October, which is Breast Cancer Awareness month.

Leaves 4 Life are ceramic leaves that can be purchased and personalized to honor the courage and spirit of those touched by breast cancer. The leaves will be displayed at Celebration Plaza at the Botanical Gardens of Western Colorado.

Proceeds from this project will help fund mammography screenings and exams for low-income and uninsured women in Mesa County and scholarships for "2nd Battle" Survivor Retreats and the Lynette Jennings Foundation's Eagleheart Center for Arts and Inquiry.

The leaves can be a tribute to someone who has survived cancer, in honor of someone who has lost their battle or simply as a contribution to this worthy cause.

Each tile leaf is a permanent and lasting high-fired ceramic ordered to be made with your wording by one of Eagleheart's artists. There are three styles and sizes of leaves:

- **Walnut Leaf** (\$50) - Approx. 4" x 7" can be stamped with up to 16

characters.

- **Cottonwood Leaf** (\$150) - Approx. 5" x 9" can be stamped with up to 24 characters.
- **Oak Leaf** (\$250) - Approx. 6" x 12" can be stamped with up to 50 characters.

Your leaves will then be installed in benches and a new sculptural water feature at the Western Colorado Botanical Gardens call Celebration Plaza. This exciting pedestrian plaza and walk-way will provide a place of family gathering as well as quiet meditation.
